What is the Virtual Track Cup supposed to be?

As in previous years, unfortunately, almost no competitions in unicycle racing take place this year. Therefore, we want to offer again all interested athletes an alternative and a small training incentive. The idea of the Virtual Track Cup is that everyone can do the disciplines they are interested in during training as part of a "measurement day" or a small "club championship". Participation is therefore not bound to a specific location. The results can then be submitted on the results form provided by the host and from all the results submitted the joint Virtual Track Cup ranking will be created, which will then be published.

Participation eligibility

All unicyclists, regardless of their country of residence, are eligible to participate. Participation is **free of charge**.

Submission of results

Results can be submitted on the results form provided by the host until the submission deadline on 06.11.2022 to the e-mail address **Jan@tvjuechen.de**. Receipt of the results will be confirmed.

Unfortunately, results submitted later cannot be taken into account for the ranking.

General information

This call for competition is for the Virtual Track Cup 2022. There will be no separate registration. All athletes interested in participating have the opportunity to send in their personal results by the submission deadline (06.11.2022) using the results form provided, participation will then be automatic. By sending in the results, the participant or, in the case of underage participants, the parent or legal guardian accepts the call for competition and declares that he/she agrees to the storage of personal data - for details see section "Privacy". If the results are transmitted by the club, the club declares to have the necessary consent of all athletes or their legal guardians.

The host accepts no liability for accidents or other damages. Sports club members are usually insured through their clubs. Lack of insurance cover (e.g. without membership in a club) cannot be blamed on the host.

Rules and Regulations / Starting and Riding Rules

For the competitions of the Virtual Track Cup 2022, the IUF rules and regulations in the 2019 version apply, which can be found at <http://iufinc.org/publications> or <http://einrad-bdr.de/?page=regelwerke> as well as the supplementary regulations of this call for competition.

The determination of personal results should take place within the framework of a competition or club training. For this purpose, a "measurement day" or a small "club championship" can be organised - the results can then be transferred to the result form and submitted for the Virtual Track Cup. On the result form, the coach or a supervisor confirms the correctness of all data. The timing can of course be done by hand timing.

The applicable official and club internal COVID 19 pandemic regulations must be unconditionally observed by all participants. All participants undertake to achieve their performance fairly and without the use of aids or other manipulations to gain an advantage.

Wertungskategorien

The Virtual Track Cup is scored separately according to age groups. In addition, there is a junior and a senior classification that includes all U15 and all 15+ age groups, respectively. The age of the participant on the submission deadline (06.11.2022) is decisive for the classification in the age groups. Male and female athletes will be judged separately. Age groups will not be combined. A classification will be made in the following age groups:

Disciplines

The Virtual Track Cup is open to results in the following official IUF disciplines:

- 100 m
- 400 m
- 800 m
- 50 m One Foot
- 10 m Wheel Walk (up to and including 10 years) / 30 m Wheel Walk (from 11 years)
- IUF-Slalom
- Coasting
- High Jump over Bar
- Long Jump on Track

Unicycles / Wheel sizes / Crank lengths

The following standard unicycles are permitted for all disciplines:

| | |
|-------------------------------------|---|
| Up to and including 10 years | Maximum unicycles of the 20 Class Outer diameter of the tire max. 518 mm Crank length min. 100 mm |
| From 11 years | Maximum unicycles of the 24 Class Outer diameter of the tire max. 618 mm Crank length min. 125 mm |

Notes: It is allowed to ride a unicycle that is fully compliant with a smaller class. There is no crank length restriction for wheel walk and coasting. There are no wheel size or crank length restrictions for the jumping disciplines.

Sicherheitsausrüstung

In principle, the club's internal regulations apply. We recommend the obligation to wear shoes, gloves, helmet and knee pads for all disciplines! The riders should always pay attention to short-bound footwear. Elbow pads are recommended.

Special rule for Long Jump: Shin guards are additionally recommended.

Special rule for High Jump: Only shoes and helmet should be mandatory, but shin guards are strongly recommended, as well as gloves and knee pads.

Awards

Each participant receives a certificate with his personal results. This will be provided in electronic form.

Sales item

The hosts - Fachschaft Einrad im Bund Deutscher Radfahrer e.V. and TV 1879 e.V. Jüchen – store the following personal data of the club contact person/trainer/supervisor for the purpose of organizing the Virtual Track Cup 2022:

- Last name, first name
- Mail address
- Club
- Address (only if shipping of event wristbands is desired)

From the participants the following personal data are needed for the purpose of the scoring:

- Last name, first name
- Sex
- Date of birth
- Club
- Achieved performances in the disciplines selected in the result form

By participating in the Virtual Track Cup 2022, the participant declares that he/she agrees to the storage and publication of personal data related to the competition. In the case of underage participants, the declaration is made by the parent or legal guardian.

Furthermore, the hosts will pass on these data to technical service providers, if this is necessary for the realization of the Virtual Track Cup. These service providers will use these data exclusively on behalf of the hosts and in no case for their own business purposes.

If no permanent storage of the data takes place, this concerns in particular the data necessary for the documentation of the results, the personal data are deleted with the end of the Virtual Track Cup. Legal archiving periods remain unaffected by this. In all other respects we refer to the data protection guideline of the BDR (www.rad-net.de).
